MINIMUM LAW ENFORCEMENT QUALIFICATIONS

General Duties of a Deputy Sheriff - Responds to and investigates all calls for service, performs proactive patrol and traffic enforcement, conducts criminal investigations, prepares written reports and criminal cases for prosecution, serves adult abuse orders and all types of civil process, ensures care, custody, and control of inmates, inmate transports, school resource officers, and other duties as assigned.

- 1. Missouri POST Certified Peace Officer Minimum 21 years of age.
- 2. Reside within the State of Missouri and within 30 minutes response time of the Law Enforcement Enforcement Center within 90 days of employment.
- 3. Pass a written exam at 70% or above.
- 4. Pass a oral screening board at 70% or above and interviews.
- 5. Successfully pass a background investigation.
- 6. Weight in proportion to height.
- 7. Vision Corrected distant vision 20/20 in each eye.
- 8. Successfully pass a physical/medical examination as established by the Sheriff's Department.
- 9. Successfully pass a drug screening examination.
- 10. Meet identity requirements as required by federal law.
- 11. No Protective Order or on probation/parole, no criminal record charges pending, never convicted of a felony.
- 12. Successful completion of all required training.
