

**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS
TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE
OVAL () COMPLETELY. (USE
ONLY THE MARKER PROVIDED.)**

An oval () blackened completely to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.

To vote a straight party ticket blacken an oval () completely in the Party Column, to the left of the name of the party of your choice.

To vote for an individual candidate of another party after blackening in the Party Oval, blacken the () to the left of the name.

To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, cross out a name which appears on the ballot for the office and write the name of the person for whom he or she wishes to vote above or below the crossed out name and blacken the oval to the left of the crossed-out name.

“STATUTORY MEASURES”

PROPOSITION A

(Proposed by Initiative Petition)

Shall there be enacted a Missouri statute to establish a Natural Streams System made up of specific Missouri streams, tributaries and related lands: to be regulated and protected through creation of a Natural Streams Commission and through adoption of management plans and regulation — developed with local input — that maintain existing lawful uses while regulating the future use of the System by prohibiting activities such as the construction of dams and the use of certain motorized vehicles; and by establishing fees for certain System users with revenue from those fees used to help finance administration of this act? Annual administrative costs ranging from \$1,270,000 to \$2,600,000 with \$10,000 to \$1,250,000 from General Revenue and \$85,000 from the Highway Fund, not including possible legal challenges. Permit fees of \$2,700,000 to Natural Streams Fund.
